**Part A :**

**What is the plan of action chalked out by the IQAC in the beginning of the year towards quality enhancement & what is the outcome by the end of the year ?**

Internal Quality Assurance Cell of the college met on April 24, 2006 in the college campus. Resolutions in the form of following suggestions were passed by the members.

1. The members were unanimous in concluding that due to rapid growth of the college, lack of space is proving an impediment in the further development of the college. Future planing on this aspect is long overdue & this aspect needs immediate attention.
2. Members recommended that girls common room should be improved and properly equipped.
3. New toilets for male & female staff members should be constructed at convenient points.
4. The college should introduce Post Graduate courses. The members recommended commerce & economics subjects to start with.
5. Placement cell needs to be installed & teachers assigned this job on rotation basis. This work should be shouldered by the teachers over & above their normal work.
6. Psychology Department should introduce various programmes that aim at improving the work culture of the non-teaching staff & also their personality development.
7. Computer Department should get more involved in conducting short courses aimed at imparting basic knowledge about the working of the computer to the staff & the students.

8. Departmental Libraries especially in Arts & Commerce faculties should be strengthened so that students get a better access to the books as desired by them through the feedback.
9. Conduct of more Seminars / Conferences / Workshops in the college on regular basis is desired.

**Action initiated on the suggestions made by IQAC is as follows :**

**1. Future planning regarding infrastructure :**

The college being situated in the heart of the city has a locational advantage in particular for women students. However, space crunch is being felt of late, on account of the class rooms and the laboratories. The IQAC members unanimously expressed concern on this count. The same was conveyed to the Management. The Management has taken note of this & are on the job.

**2. Girls common room :**

The girls common room has been improved to the satisfaction of the students.

**3. New toilets :**

New spacious toilets for women have been constructed in the newly erected hostel block.

**4. Introduction of P.G. classes :**

Acting on the recommendation of IQAC, the college authorities approached the university for grant of permission to start P. G. Courses in Computer Science, Economics & Commerce. The university authorities have recommended the case to the government. Final sanction from the government authorities is awaited.

**5. Placement cell :**

Being an undergraduate college placement opportunities are limited. However, a cell has been framed from among the teachers. The committee is trying to get on the rails.

**6. Computer Literacy of Staff :**

Computer Department of its own is already running "Computer Literacy Course" for the benefit of students & teachers from all faculties. On the suggestion of IQAC, the department is set to identify members of staff who lack knowledge of computers with the help of a questionnaire. Staff so identified shall be persuaded to undergo this basic course in the coming session.

**7. Departmental Libraries in Arts & Commerce Faculties :**

The departments in Arts & Commerce faculties have been requested to look into this suggestion & do whatever is possible with the available facilities.

**8. Conduct of Seminar / Conference :**

A National level seminar was conducted in the college by the Geography Department in association with Pune based Deccan Geographical Society from 6 – 8 Oct. 2006. 267 participants attended & 90 research papers were presented.

A seminar titled "Ethics & Human Values has been sanctioned by U. G. C. to be conducted in this institution in the coming session. An amount of Rs. 80,000/- has been sanctioned for the purpose.

## **Part B :**

### **1. Activities reflecting the goals & objectives of the institution :**

The following activities were undertaken in the academic year 2006-2007. These go in tune with the objective of the institution.

- i. Debating club manned by a committee of 9 students under the Presidentship of Ms. Pratibha Arun Thakur (T. Y. B. Com.) organized many debating competitions & programmes at college level & many students were groomed to participate in inter-college competitions where many prizes were won.
- ii. One of the bright features in this session was that a very good number of resource persons, some of them being very prominent in their respective fields were invited to the college by various committees to deliver lectures & interact with college students. The committees included Art Circle, Ex-student Rapport Committee, Counseling & Placement Cell, Parent- Teacher Association etc.
- iii. Students of N. S. S. continued to be in the fore front by participating in different activities like 'Save Electricity' Workshop, 'Adventure Camps', 'Friendship Camps' etc.

Two rallies were conducted by N. S. S. students this year to create awareness about AIDS among the masses. First rally was organized in the city of Jalgaon on November 26, 2006. 50 students participated. The rally was organized on the eve of "Ashwamedha 2006" conducted by N. M. University, Jalgaon at the behest of Governor's office. Second rally was organized in Tarsod Village on the periphery of Jalgaon City on January 22, 2007. 15 students participated & went from door to door displaying banners & educating people.

- iv. N. C. C. students besides their routine activities like parades, camps & celebrations have flourished on other fronts too. This session 11 cadets passed 'B' Certificate & 4 cadets passed 'C' Certificate. This year Jr. Under

Officer Ms. Sangita N. Tambe was selected for 'Thal Sainik Camp' held at New Delhi from 16- 27 Sept. 2006. Sgt. Ms. Yogita N. Bonde was selected to attend 'National Integration Camp' at Warangal, Kazipeth, A. P. from 10 – 21 Nov. 2006. Sr. Under Officer Ms. Yogita P. Nerkar & Cadet Poonam B. Atale were selected to attend 'Hospital Attachment Camp' from 15 – 26 Nov. 2006 at Pune.

- v. 'Certificate course in spoken English' & 'Computer Literacy & Internet Course' were continued to be conducted this year as well. This is open to all desirous students from all faculties.
- vi. As recorded in previous reports many fruitful activities have become a regular feature. These activities have definitely made a difference over the years as can be gauged by the feed back from the alumni & the parents. These activities include the framing of Counseling Cell, Career Guidance Committee, Art Circle, Debating Club & the Earn & Learn Scheme.

Annual Social Gathering & the welcome party continue to be a star attraction & do a lot of good to the student community. Both these events are fully managed by the students without any flaw.

Feed back about all the aspects concerning the students in the college including their teachers, continues to be taken. This has helped the system to remain healthy & grow.

**17. Community Services :**

"Extension Activities Committee" framed in the college looks after this aspect by formulating programmes and involving students.

The committee organized a rally on Sept. 08, 2006 in a slum area called Hari Vitthal Nagar. The purpose of the rally was to create awareness about the importance of literacy among the public in general & women in particular. Posters were displayed all along.

A socio-economic survey of Tarsod village was undertaken on January 07, 2007. Data was collected with the help of a questionnaire. The data so collected was analysed & inferences were drawn. The results clearly high lighted the ignorance of people about threatening disease like AIDS, mosquito breeding & public health, polluted drinking water & diseases etc. As a follow of action, teachers & students revisited the village on January 11, 2007 & held meetings at different convenient points & the

villagers were briefed so as to create awareness among them on these issues. The committee shall continue with the follow up action in the coming year.

The committee members along with about 150 college students took up a drive of cleaning the Shyamaprasad Mukharji Garden on Feb. 18, 2007 & Mahatma Gandhi Garden on Feb. 24, 2007. The Gardens are in the vicinity of the college. The idea was to create awareness among the people living close by. All litter that included both decomposable & non-decomposable matter was lifted, segregated and appropriately disposed.

**22. Number of courses for which student assessment of teacher is introduced and the action taken on student feedback :**

The process of assessment of the teachers by the students was introduced in the academic year 2002-03 It continues till date. The feedback is obtained through a questionnaire. **24. Computerization of administration and the process of admissions and examination results, issue of certificates :**

Some jobs in the office were being conducted with the help of computers for the last few years. Most of the staff is Computer literate. However, this session a complete package of software has been procured for the office that shall cover all possible jobs in the office. Computerization of various office functions viz. Admission, Payroll, All type of Scholarship, Fee A/c (Daily & monthly fee register), College A/c, EBC, PTC, etc fee concession, Salary etc. have been completed. Two term end examination results conducted in the college shall hence forth be covered. Annual Examination results & issue of certificates are done by the university.

Construction of the 4 storey hostel block has been completed. It shall be allotted to the students in the coming academic session.

**26. Technology up gradation :**

1. Complete computerization of the office.
2. Computerization of the Library.
3. Computers have been installed in all science departments. All computers have access to the Internet.

**27. Computer and internet access and training to teachers and students :**

As mentioned earlier, the college has installed an Internet Center in the last academic year. It is over & above the two computer laboratories with internet facility that are already operational. All students & teachers have free access to this facility. This year computers with Internet facility have been installed in all science departments.

Computer Science Department of the college regularly conducts “Computer Literacy & Internet Programme” for the benefit of students & teachers. This year the dept. conducted “Internet access & training” course for 02 batches that covered 20 students & one batch of 08 teachers.

**28. Financial aid to students :**

Besides exemption of fees to students under various schemes of government a novel scheme titled, “Earn & Learn” continues to run in the college. Economically challenged students are identified and assigned some job in the library, college office and laboratories. The timing is so adjusted that normal college schedule of the students is not disturbed. This year 40 students got benefited under the scheme. An amount of Rs. 38,124/- was spent for the purpose.

Analysis of the feed back of parents of wards belonging to different faculties was done separately. Very precious information surfaced. The same shall be presented before IQAC in its next meeting.

Lectures for the benefit of students were arranged by the committee by inviting some parents to the college. Prof. R. D. Rane delivered a very informative lecture on “Economic empowerment of women” on Sept. 12, 2006. Adv. Sudhakar Mahajan delivered a lecture on “Women related acts & laws” on Feb. 14, 2007.

**31. Health Services :**

A modest health centre is operational in the college. 04 doctors are on call. Besides there are 02 doctors on staff in the college whose services are availed during college hours as and when needed.

A committee has been constituted in the college from among the teachers which monitors hygienic conditions in the canteen & overall sanitation etc.

**35. Activities of the career guidance and counseling committee:**

**Career Guidance Cell –**

Various lectures series were arranged for students.

**Activities of the counseling cell -**

In the beginning of the last academic session (2006-07) counseling cell counseled 98 students and their guardians on various aspects related with the admission process. These are :

- i. Proper filling of admission forms
- ii. Choice and selection of faculty / subjects best suited for a particular student.
- iii. Scholarships and Freeships that are available to a student.
- iv. Knowledge about various facilities available on the campus.

**36. Placement services provided to students :**

There is no provision for formation of a placement cell in colleges under grant in aid scheme of the government. However this activity has been entrusted to the career guidance & counseling committee from this academic year. A modest beginning has been made. The committee managed to arrange an interview of 07 students from Computer Science & Electronics Departments for placement in Wipro Company. Ms. Chanchal Y. Nehate from Computer Science Department was selected from this batch to undergo job cum study programme of the company.


**Explain the plans of the institution for the next year :**

Internal Quality Assurance Cell of the college met on 24<sup>th</sup> April, 2007. Resolutions in the form of following suggestions were passed after due consideration of the recommendations made by Quality Advisory Committee in their meeting held on 10<sup>th</sup> April, 2007. The members also took notice of the inferences from the feed back obtained from the students with the help of a questionnaire & feed back received through two suggestion boxes installed in the college.

1. Members strongly recommended that the teaching staff should be encouraged & persuaded to put to optimum use the teaching aids in the class room.
2. The college should arrange to have a web site immediately & relevant information as required under NAAC guidelines be displayed.
3. Various Committees should be encouraged to take up various programmes that can inculcate desirable social & cultural values in the students. The members suggested that students can visit old age home & interact with deserted old people. This shall rekindle fast dwindling family bonds among the students. The students can be encouraged to offer few days service at such centers preferably during vacations.
4. The college should introduce various programmes that can identify & hone various competencies among the students.
5. Another recommendation made by the committee was that sense of care for the environment should be strongly evoked among the students. They need to be sensitized.
6. Socio-economic survey of Khedi village was undertaken in the year 2001. Some corrective measures work taken in the subsequent years based on the outcome of the survey. The member suggested that yet another survey be undertaken so as to note any improvement in the condition of the people.

7. Members recommended that since all science departments have been provided with computers, they should undertake computerization of their respective departmental information.
8. In the light of boom in shopping malls, members recommended that short term retail management course be start.
9. The members recommended that in the light of changing scenario the management should prepare a master plan for coming few years projecting as to how the challenge is in particular regarding infrastructure would be faced.
10. The registration of alumni be revived. The association be strengthened. To reach the alumni advertisement in news papers be put in.s
11. Also graduation is an under qualification for placement yet placement cell can look for some jobs like receptionists, bank clerks etc. that suits the qualification of the students.
12. The members unanimously recommended that all stake holders viz. Teachers & Non teaching staff should be computer literate. To identify the members of Teaching & Non teaching staff who need improvement, a questionnaire be prepared for the purpose. The staff so identified be made to undertake a brief course in computers.
13. As per the feed back from teachers it has come to light that students do not willingly undertake projects that were introduced a few years back since these do not carry any weightage by way of marks. The members recommended that projects of preliminary nature be introduced that do not interfere in the regular learning of the students. The projects may be more of a hobby type that will help the students to improve their writing skills, let them handle computer etc.
14. Members desired that some teachers from the college be deputed to some other institutions so as to have a first hand information about various matters like infrastructure & its optimum use, innovative methods employed in teaching, good administrative measures, management of the institution, functioning of the office, library set up etc.
15. As regards maintenance of the sanitation & cleanliness in the college, the members recommended involvement of external agency on contract basis.

16. To keep up the tempo in the students, women entrepreneurs should be regularly invited to the college & made to interact with students. This will sow the seeds of entrepreneurial bent of mind.
17. Based on the outcome of the students' feed back increased numbers of copies of news papers should be made available to the students in the reading rooms.
18. To improve the services rendered by the Non teaching staff some experts be invited & a workshop on work culture be conducted for the benefit of the said staff.
