Annual Quality Assurance Report of the IQAC
(2010-11)

Part A :

What is the plan of action chalked out by the IQAC in the beginning of the year towards quality enhancement & what is the outcome by the end of the year ?

The action plan of the Institution for the year 2010-11 :

Internal Quality Assurance Cell of the college met on 29th April 2010. Resolutions in the form of following suggestions were passed. The members also took notice of the inferences from the feedback obtained from the students with the help of a questionnaire & also the feedback received through two suggestion boxes & feedback from the guardians /parents.

- 1) It was suggested that the earlier plan of purchasing an adjacent building should be abandoned. So as to pursue a new plan of 3 / 4 storey building on the campus to ease out the pressure on the main campus.
- 2) A master plan for the infrastructure development is to be prepared for improved and modernized basic amenities like canteen, girls common room, spacious Gym, cosmetic changes in staff room, sanitary units etc.
- 3) It was suggested that more concentration should be on doctoral and post doctoral research along with seeking new ways of revenues by submitting proposals to different funding agencies.
- 4) It was resolved to submit a proposal for the women study centre to the UGC.
- 5) It was suggested that the library should become a source of knowledge and the students must have a free access to books in the library. The computerization of the library in the real sense of the term, is to be completed in the near future.

- 6) It was resolved that the I.Q.A.C. must meet frequently in the year to come in the light of the Reaccreditation process to be geared up.

The outcome of the Action Plan during 2010-11 :

- 1) As per the recommendations of the IQAC, the earlier plan of purchasing an adjacent building was abandoned and a new master plan of renovating the campus was taken up to ease out the pressure on the Main Campus
- 2) The Management prepared and pursued vigorously the New Master Plan which has realized following significant changes in the infrastructure of the College, aiming at quality enhancement in the imparting of the Higher Education to the stake-holders :-
 - i) A new, one more, fifth, floor has been built on the New Building No. II with an elevator.
 - ii) The Office Blocks have been shifted to the Ground Floor of the New Building No. II from the Ground Floor of the Old Main Building.
 - iii) The Four Floors of the New Building have been renovated and reconstructed to accommodate the Science Laboratories, Language Lab., Staff Room, Women staff Restroom, Other Departments, Principal's Chamber, Classrooms, and the other basic infrastructure amenities for the students and the Staff, which were earlier scattered in the Main Building and the New Building No. I
 - iv) The Canteen, Girl's Common Room, Spacious Gym, Sanitary Units, UGC Network Centre etc. have been renovated and modernized to meet the stakeholders needs.
 - v) The Library has been extended with spacious reading hall, reference section, stacking room, issuing counters, Librarian's Office etc.
 - vi) The Competitive Exam Guidance Centre has been enriched with Modern classroom T/L methods and an adjacent library so as to satisfy the needs of the enrolling ambitious youths
 - vii) The Memoranda of Understanding with the Sports Officers of the Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj Krida Sankul and with the Eklavya Krida

Sankul have been continued to provide outdoor games facilities for our students.

- 3) As per the suggestion of the IQAC concentrated efforts were made on doctoral research alongwith seeking new ways of revenues by submitting proposals to different funding agencies
 - Two Teachers completed their Ph.D.s and one teacher availed of the F.I. P. provision from the UGC. 12 teachers have applied for Ph.D. registrations.
 - Three Teachers applied for Major / Minor Research Projects and have received sanction letters as well.
- 4) A **Proposal for the Women Study Centre** has been prepared by a Committee headed by Principal Dr. S.S. Rane, who has been nominated on the North Maharashtra University's Women Study Centre as an expert. The Proposal has been forwarded to the UGC.
- 5) The library has applied for the INFLIBNET services. The Library has also provided an 'open access' to books for the PG students. Its computerization has been completed with the introduction of new, all-accommodative, need-based software.
- 6) The IQAC has bid farewell to Prof. Dr. Yograj Vaishnavi, Dr. S.R.Chirmade, Prof. T.K. Attarde and Dr. P.I. Chaudhari after their enriching association with the Cell for more than ten years. However, their substitution with Hon'ble members like Principal Dr. Naresh Chandra, Principal Anil Rao and Dr. V.L. Maheshwari has opened new vistas of academic guidance and deliberations which would help the College to realize its dream of 'College with Potential for Excellence'.
- 7) The duly completed two reports of the IQAC for the years 2008-09, 2009-10 have submitted to the NAAC, Bangalore. Intent Letter has been sent for the second time on 5th September 2010 and the Steering Committee has compiled a voluminous draft of the College Activities and Assets in two parts the Supplementary Report for the period 2003-05 and the Main Report 2005-10.

Part B :

1. **Activities reflecting the goals & objectives of the Institution :**

The Goals and Objectives of the Institution are well reflected in the various Curricular, Co-curricular, Extra-curricular & Extension Activities, which help our students to groom into good citizens of India. Our activities not only help them to become knowledgeable but also empower them to pursue any career in their lives.

There are various committees to explore the hidden merits of our students such as the Arts Circle, Science Association, Gymkhana Committee, Career Guidance & Placement Cell, UPSC/ MPSC Competitive Exam Guidance & Counseling Centre, Planning Forum, Debating club Students', Welfare Committee, Extension Activities Committee etc. These Committees co-ordinate various programmes so as to bring out the hidden talent. - **On 15th August 2010**, the Mothers / Wives of Martyrs were felicitated in the presence of Prof. Shekhar Sonalkar, a veteran social-worker. Lt. R.P. Sing presided over the function.
- On the same day, N.S.S. volunteers organized an exhibition on 'Disaster Management'.
- On the 'Day of Rakshabandhan', the volunteers visited the Remand Home and bound the threads of sisterly love on the wrists of the juveniles and presented variety entertainment programme.
- The volunteers had a dialogue with Mrs. Meera Borwankar, the Commissioner of Police, Pune to get information about careers through Competitive Exams. They also had a talk with Miss. Snehal Salunkhe, a Gold medalist from the Beijing Olympics, to know career in sports.
- Vocational training camp was held to provide for manufacturing Finile, Liquid soap, Washing Powder, Facepack, Honey- pack, Pigmentation pack etc. The resource person was Mrs. Ratna Khadke while Mrs. Neha Chaudhari trained the participants with demonstration on Skin Treatment, Skin Problems, Hair Problems, Scientific Hair Combing, Clean-up Treatment, Facial for Oily & Dry Skin, Make-up for Reception etc.

B] The N.C.C. unit pursued various regular and some noteworthy activities to bring into practice their motto : ' A strong nation with sound Body and Mind'.

- Our cadets actively participated in the Energy Conservation awareness Rally, Streetplays for Eradication of Superstitions, Snake-exhibition, Water Literacy etc. under the Village-adoption Programme, which took place in the village, Jalgaon-Khurd.

- 06 cadets passed '**B**' cert exam, while 09 cadets got through the '**C**' cert exam. 02 cadets namely Vishakha Mungad and Mamta Deore bagged 'A' Grade in the '**B**' cert exam., while Roshani Jangid and Priya Bari snatched 'A' grade in the '**C**' cert exam.
- Our cadets are skilled in piloting and hence, on various occasions the piloting of Chief- Guests by our cadets has been appreciated.

C] The Arts Circle, the Extension Activities Committee, and other committees organized various programmes to inculcate the abilities amongst our students that enable them to realize their dreams and achieve peaks of successes. 'Annual Social Gathering' one of the big bonanza for the students to hone their talents and prepare for the 'Yuvarang' at the University level.

D] The feedback Committee got filled the Feedback questionnaires from the outgoing students and parents on various support services provided on Campus. The consolidated report was submitted to the Principal, who appraised the Management of the Stakeholders expectations and aspirations from the Institution, the staff and Library. The Report on the Infrastructure questionnaire has particularly helped the Management to adopt a new, revised Master-Plan that accommodated various upgraded facilities for the students at large.

E] The Anti-ragging Committee and Cell against Sexual Harassment, jointly inspire the Senior Students from the S.Y. & T.Y. to organize faculty wise Fresher's Days for the new entrants. The seniors enjoy full freedom to organize the programmes so as to acquaint the Freshers with the Campus Culture and activities.

Being an affiliated College, innovations in curricular design are made and communicated by the North Maharashtra University, Jalgaon. 17. Community Services :

- The Extension Activities Committee has been framed for this purpose. It has been actively undertaking extension activities, which would be suitable for the U.G. Students and identify them with real life situation. It also tries to build the personalities of the students empowering them to pursue the careers of their own choices and capabilities, while developing a sense social belonging / commitment to Society.

Some of the major community services extended by the College are listed below -

- The Department of Chemistry arranges visits to industries to identify real life problems for T.Y.B.Sc. projects and tries to establish linkages between the industry and College, so as to bring funds if any, for future research, & Studies; or even to create opportunities of jobs for students.
- The Department of Commerce and E.S. Committee along with Career Guidance & Placement Cell, organize exhibitions, training camps and Campus interviews. These Extension activities help not only students but also generators of resources as well.
- Departments of Languages (Marathi, Hindi, English) actively inspire the students to participate and prepare for debating / oratory competitions.

Similarly, the creative minds are encouraged to write stories, poems and also given opportunities to present their works of arts' in different competitions like poetry-recitation, story-writing & telling, Magazine competition etc.

- The Psychology Department runs the Psychological Counseling Centre to extend counseling to the stakeholders about their personal, psychological problems and academic ones.
- The N.S.S. unit organized various programmes to create awareness about pollution free living, literacy, clean campus, water management etc.
- The N.C.C. unit also organized complementary activities like 'Salute to the Mothers and Wives of the Martyrs' to instill and augment the nationalistic tendencies amongst the students and the society at large.
- The Competitive Examination Guidance Centre conducted a university level talent-search exam for civil services –'Jidnyasa-2010' in which 7000 students from 52 centres, involving 135 educational institutions, spread throughout the 03 districts – Jalgaon, Nandurbar and Dhule appeared, having their base prepared with the reference material of 10000 question answer in objective format compiled under the title – 'Lakshya-2010'. This extension activity of the College, would certainly complement to realize the rural Youth's dream of joining the prestigious, secured civil services.

The College was established in 1984 with a motto to provide education at different levels for the girls from rural area. Near about 2264 girl students have enrolled during the academic year 2010-11 for various courses from the Science, Arts and Commerce faculties.

The proactive management provides financial and academic autonomy.

We have our own building in the heart of the city to ensure the safety of the students. A hostel on the campus with all the facilities is also available. College has a rich Central Library having books, research journals and periodicals. The Library is being computerized to facilitate the speedy location of books. College provides some specific programs to provide financial aid to the students. Earn & Learn Scheme is one of it.

Model classroom equipped with modern T / L facilities is available. One assembly hall having capacity of 250 chairs with modern AV Aids is in day to day use for various programs in the college and the Sarswati hall with a capacity of 500 persons is in use for various extra curricular activities.

All departments are thriving with energetic and academic faculty members, many of whom are involved in research, projects, creative writing and other extension activities. Two of our faculty members are Chief Editors of International Journals – Dr. Ram Prakash is the Editor in Chief of the International journal of 'Pharmacology and Biological Sciences', Dr. V.J. Patil is the Associate Editor of 'Journal of Research and Development' while one of our teachers – Prof. B.P. Savakhedkar is the General Secretary of the Teachers Organization on the University level. Many of the teachers have completed their minor research projects and 04 are still engaged with on-going projects.

College publishes an annual magazine 'Shardiya' to give vent to creative voices of the students. The magazine has received many awards so far by the North Maharashtra University.

College also runs professional courses to provide job opportunities for the students. We have a Placement Cell in the college. Our college has the Chanakya Competitive Examination Guidance Centre for MPSC, UPSC and
