## SECTION : C

### The outcome of the Action Plan during 2012-13 :

It gives us an immense pleasure to communicate a success-story : **Our College has been awarded Grade 'A' ( with CGPA 3.11 ) by the NAAC, Bangalore** after receiving and evaluating the report of the Peer Team that visited the Campus on 4<sup>th</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> October 2012, for Re-assessment and Re-accreditation of our College.

We firmly believe that the success-story has been that outcome of the Team work of the Teaching – Nonteaching staff, carried out under the able guidance of the liberal, considerate and pragmatic management. Therefore, a very 'down to earth' action plan was chalked out, the results of which are as given below -

- ❖ The Elevator in the newly developed four-storey building is the need of the hour. And hence, the Jalgaon Municipal corporation was vigorously pursued for due permission, but sans fruit !. The place and infrastructure provided for the lift, still awaits for being used.
- ❖ With the growing computerisation of the Campus, a strong need of continuous electricity supply was felt. So, as per the I.Q.A.C.'s suggestion two generators, each of 125 KVA capacity were installed in the Main Admin Wing. And, hence, even during 06 hours of intermittent load shading, practical can be conducted, computers can be run and classrooms are lit and properly ventilated.
- ❖ The I.Q.A.C.'s suggestion of 'giving more stress on research orientation', has been implemented in its true spirit –
  - The Research Committee, which consists of eminent and experienced teachers, facilitated and monitored research activity. It was in constant touch with the teachers involved in research and guided them to carry out quality research. Successful teachers are felicitated on the completion of their research work and they are also motivated to publish their research work. Desirous teachers are encouraged and guided to prepare outlines of research works and submit them to different funding agencies to avail of funds. As a result of these research promotional endeavours, 43 teachers are involved in the research activities, in various ways – some publish their research papers in research journals, present their works in different conferences, compile research articles and papers in the form of books, two of the heads of the Departments publish international journals

of their respective subjects, some of the Ph.D. holders work as research guides for M.Phil. and Ph.D. students.

- The Committee, in the framework of guidelines, provided by the Institution, promote participation of students in research activities by providing them financial assistance, to take up socio-economic survey, opinion polls or even to attend seminars and conferences or participate in different research activities like 'Avishkar-2013 and total 19 projects were submitted in this research festival.

Accordingly the institution has made adequate financial provision for research and development and also took initiative for collaborative research with Jalasri, VEGA Chemicals and the M. J. College, Jalgaon.

All these endeavours have given positive results, which are recorded in the reply to point No. 07 to 17.

- ❖ Targeted efforts realized the dream of achieving the coveted status of the College-certified under ISO 9001 : 2008. The D.N.V. Pune ( International Firm for Standardisation ) scrutinised all the departments, office, library, gymkhana and services provided by the College on the guidelines provided by the Firm and accredited the College for 03 years as ISO 9001 : 2008 certified College, from 2012 to 2015 on 17<sup>th</sup> April 2013. Lead Auditors Mr. Randhir Koranne and Dr. Manish Lale audited the Departments of English, Physics, Computer Sciences and the M. C. V. C. Departments and library for Internal Audits as per the provisions of the Firm. Mr. Anil Deshpande, Pune guided the exercise.

Ms. R. N. Mahajan worked as the Management Representative and Mr. P. D. Patil and Mr. P. N. Bhirud were Joint M.R.

- ❖ Being one of the leading Women's Colleges from the Khandesh, a need to establish a functional Women Study Centre was felt and accordingly a proposal was sent to the UGC. Dr. Narayan Bhosale perused the proposal.

Meanwhile, the North Maharashtra University has established a Women Study Centre with a full-fledged teaching- non-teaching staffing pattern. An adhoc Board of Studies in Women Studies has also been established. Principal Dr. S.S. Rane has been nominated as its member and Faculty member as well as by Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor, N. M. University, Jalgaon.

Besides, the College organizes different gender-sensitization programmes to make the student aware not only of their rights and honour, but also to empower them with the psychophysical abilities in this world full of adversities for them from birth till death.

- ❖ In the light of the preparations for ISO 9001 : 2008 and the Re-assessment and Re-accreditation by the NAAC, the College could not organise conferences / seminars as suggested by the IQAC. However now having got 'A' grade by the NAAC and certified ISO 9001 : 2008 College , we assure the Honourable members of the IQAC that conferences and seminars will be organised with a renewed Zeal and vigour in the coming Academic year.
- ❖ As regards to the training programmes for the non-teaching staff, the College founded the Non-teaching Staff Academy, which organises informative and enlightening lectures of teachers and trainers from our College and outside. During the year under Report 03 such lectures on variety of topics were organised. Similarly the College deputed concerned supportive staff for the training programmes [such as online Registration for PG Courses] organised by the North Maharashtra University, Jalgaon.
- ❖ More vocational programs under the banner Aishwarya Vocational Centre have been introduced for women's freedom from age-old exploitation through social and economic empowerment. The newly introduced vocational programs are Beauty Therapy, Cooking and Baking, Soft Toys Making, Tailor-ladies etc. The University Grants Commission has sanctioned a funding of Rs.5,00,000/- for Web designing under the XIth Plan.
- ❖ Regarding Potential autonomy for the College, informal discussions with the staff-members were held. The Steering Committee has plans to organise a seminar on this issue. A proposal to that effect is under process.
- ❖ On the issue of the Faculty and Students Exchange Program the College has decided to seek opportunities in collaboration with the NMU, Jalgaon, which has entered into MOU with some foreign universities. Similarly, the teaching staff is instructed to take benefits of the MOUs done with the SSVPS College of Arts and Science, Dhule, P. K. Kotech Mahila College, Bhusawal and M. J. College, Jalgaon in this regard.
