




Due to their constant guidance and unconditional support, today our college has good reputation in Maharashtra.

Restraint must not be imposed upon the student's search for or consideration of diverse or contrary opinion. He further said this profession requires that the teacher should be calm, patient and communicative by temperament and amiable in disposition. 


❖ Session- III QAC & NAAC by Dr. Smita Chaudhary I.Q.A.C. Coordinator

Chaudhary madam guided to the faculty about “NAAC: Introduction, Assessment and Functioning”. During her lecture she explained the NAAC, its establishment and Vision of NAAC. She said to check and assess the quality of the higher institutions, an autonomous and independent

organization called The National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC) was established by the University Grants Commission (UGC) of India in 1994. She explained the core objective of NAAC is to enhance and improve the quality of higher education in the country. NAAC Assessment and Accreditation is a Team Work. She explained stages of NAAC Assessment and Accreditation framework. She introduced all 7 Criteria's, Key indicators, Quality and Quantitative metrics. It gives the institution a new sense of direction and identity. It provides the society with reliable information about Institution and Promotes intra- and inter-institutional interactions. It becomes a symbol of quality general public can rely upon. It helps develop leadership qualities". At the end of this session Ms. Mamta Jain proposed vote of thanks.

❖ Session- III Introduction to Autonomy by Prof. Hundiwale



In the lecture he informed about the role and need of the autonomy. He elaborated the topic by highlighting the objectives of autonomy as per the National Policy on Education & talked about what kind of freedom is available for autonomous colleges & how autonomous colleges determine and prescribe their own courses of study and syllabi, and restructure and redesign the courses to suit local needs. He also enlightened the faculty by giving the further relevant details on the concerned topic such as difference between a Deemed University and an Autonomy College, fee structure in autonomous college, what is the benefit to the students and teachers of autonomous college? & what are the pre-requisites for becoming autonomous? He concluded the topic with

answering the doubts and queries of the faculty. At the end Ms. Shubhangi Bhavsar proposed vote of thanks.
