It gives me great pleasure to present the report of Dr. Annasaheb G. D. Bendale Mahila Mahavidyalaya, Jalgaon for the academic year 2022-23. The continuous progress of the college with the active participation and cooperation of the honourable management, faculty, students, alumni, parents and non-teaching colleagues is a matter of pride.

The academic year 2022-23 started from August 1st, 2022. 1692 students in senior college and post-graduate department had 265 students, 1199 students in junior college. A total of 3686 students including 138 students for Vocational Degree Course, 160 students for Higher Secondary Business Education Course, 20 students for Skill Courses running on a self-financing basis were enrolled.

The guidance for UPSC, MPSC, Cops recruitment, Banking Services and Staff Selection Commission exams will be provided through visits of IAS under Career Katta. Along with this under the visits of entrepreneurs, guidance will be provided for entrepreneur personality, management skills, actual entrepreneur's guidance, financial management decision ability and modern technology. The college has received the honour as Centre for Excellence under Career Katta, under this honour college will get rupees 10 lakhs (2 lakhs per year for continuous 5 years). The preparation for competitive exams, study room, Entrepreneur Development Centre, Skill Development Centre and 50 add-on courses will be made available from this grant. Students can enrol for these courses after paying rupees 365; registration fee to Career Katta.

Organization of Amrit Mohotsav of Indian Independence -

On the completion of 75 years of Indian independence, the Department of Student Development, Kavayitri Bahinabai Chaudhari North Maharashtra University, Jalgaon and Dr Annasaheb GD Bendale Mahila Mahavidyalaya jointly organised 16 programs. The university has provided funding for those programmes. In these programmes, there were Scholarly Lectures, Tableau, Marathon, Patriotic events such as -An eve on the Name of Nation (Ek Sham Desh ke Naam), Stories of Memoriam, Short Films, One Act Play, Self-Composed Poetry Recitation, Ghazal Singing Competition, Poster Presentation, Patriotic Songs, Lay Singing, Slogan Composition, G.K. Competition and National seminar successfully organised under the guidance of hon, principle Prof. Dr. Gauri Rane, Dr. Jayendra Lekurwale was the coordinator for these all programmes.

Organization of Fashion Show - 2023

The Beaufa Pageant Fashion Show was organised on 27 December 2022 by the school of Skill Development Department. The inauguration of this event has been done by hon. Prof. V.P. Hole; the director of the institution. The event was attentive to all for its special theme "Desh Rangila" as the celebration of Amrit Mohotsav year of Indian independence. Apart from this various themes were also kept in this fashion show. 100 models have participated in the programme. Best Model, Best Beauty Artist and Best Fashion Designer theses prizes were also offered in the fashion show. Miss Vijaya Manmode fashion designer from Pune and jury of state level competitions, and beauty artist Harshada Gaikwad were present as juries for the event.

Organization of Devgiri Short Film Festival -

The Devgiri short film festival was jointly organized on 11 and 12th January 2023 by the Dr Annasaheb G D Bendale Mahila Mahavidyalaya, Jalgaon and Ajintha Film Society Jalgaon. Picture Rally, Master Class, Video Conference, Touring Talkies, Exhibition of Ranragini film, Film Screening, Talk with Youngsters, Film Exhibitions, Cultural Programme, and Prize Distribution, these all events were conducted in this festival. Many dignitaries were present for the event among them there was Hon. Vice Chancellor of Kavayitri Bahinabai Chaudhari North Maharashtra University, Professor V.L. Maheshwari, Pro Vice Chancellor, Prof. S.T. Ingale, Music Artist Aroh Velankar, Shri. Chandrashekhar Kulkarni, famous film director Shantanu Rode, famous musician Rohit Nagbhide etc. 92 Short Films from all over Maharashtra attended the programme. The programme was succeeded with the participation of approximately 3000 participants.

♦ Organization of NSS Camp -

Special (Work-mannerism-inculcation) Camp is organized from 17th January 2023 to 23 January by the National Service Scheme Unit of the college at the Health Centre of Kavayitri Bahinabai Chaudhari North Maharashtra University and in the foster village Takarkheda, Taluka Erandol. 125 volunteers have participated in this camp. The inauguration of the camp was done with the auspicious hands of notable alumni of the college, Dr. Madhulika Sonawane in the presence of Shri. Sharad Patil, Dr Sachin Nandre, Director of NSS KBCNMU. Scholarly Lectures and programmes on Clean India, Pollution, Save Girl - Educate Girl Campaign, Amrit Mohotsavi Bharat, Bio-diversity, Voter Awareness, Environment, Tree Plantation and Conservation, Education, etc. were conducted in the camp. Volunteers have contributed to social work through the rally, street play, and collaboration to labour work, tree plantation and cleaning at foster village Takarkheda. The Sarpanch of the village, Shri Pravin Patil was helped for the arrangement of the

camp. Principal Dr Gauri Rane, NSS Program Officer Dr. Shila Rajput, Prof. Ratnprabha Mahajan and Dr. Deepak Kinge have contributed to attaining the success of the camp.

Organization of Dandiya Dance Training Workshop -

Dandiya dance training workshop was organized for the students by Art Forum (Kala Mandal) from *Ghatsthapna* to *Dussehra*. Shri. Ajay Shinde; a dance trainer and his colleagues have given training to 200 students. This is an attempt to inculcate the cultural sense and importance of dandiya exercise among the students.

Nutrition and Health Guidance Workshop -

One day workshop on nutrition and health was held in collaboration with the Lifelong Learning and Extension Department, Kavayitri Bahinabai Chaudhari North Maharashtra University Jalgaon and Extension Activity Committee of the college and Department of Physical Education, Annasaheb Dr. G D Bendale Mahila Mahavidyalaya Jalgaon. 116 students have actively participated in the workshop. Dr. Anita Kolhe and Dr. Dipak Kinge have coordinated the workshop

Help to students from the Students Support Fund Scheme -

The amount is submitted with the collection of the Student Support Fund to help the students to pay their admission fees and education fees from the amount being donated by teaching and non teaching colleagues of the college on the occasion of their birthdays. On the basis of good academic records and knowing the financial status of their families two students of each department, including 56 students were supported with the inclusive amount of rupees 72000 in the academic year 2023-24. Students from deprived sections are brought into the educational mainstream with financial support from the scheme.

Various Skill Based Programs started in the college -

As per statute 181, various certificate programs have been started in various subjects.

Students will have opportunities to get employment from those all in the near future. With this, the students are getting updated knowledge which increases their employable quality and abilities.

Organization of Budding Research Program for new researchers -

Aiming to inculcate research aptitude among the students of various faculties of UG and PG departments of the college, the budding research program is being initiated. Students have prepared qualitative and excellent research projects in various subjects. Total 91 students have participated in the program in the academic year 2023-24. They have completed 46 minor research projects with the guidance of their respective research guides. These research projects have been evaluated by 16 external referees who are invited from various colleges. The students whose projects were found good were honoured with cash prizes in the special event organized on 29th April 2023 where students were offered certificates and cash prices with auspicious hands of chief guest of the program Prof. B.L. Chaudhari; head of the Microbiology Department, Kavayitri Bahinabai Chaudhari North Maharashtra University, Jalgaon. The vice principal of the college Dr. V.J. Patil was the coordinator for this program.

Organization of National Conference –

On March 25, 2023, a national conference was organized by the college on the topic 'Research in Bio, Geo, Chemical Sciences: A Global Scenario' in association with the department of Botany, Zoology, Geography and Chemistry. Total Rs. 30,000/- grant was received for this conference from KBC North Maharashtra University, Jalgaon. 17 research papers were read and 35 poster presentations were done in this conference. The research papers presented in it were published in a book with ISBN number.
