#### **Our Strengths**

#### NAAC Accreditation and ISO Certification

The college has maintained 'A' Grade in two consecutive NAAC accreditation cycles. In the current 3rd cycle it is re-accredited and awarded 'A' Grade with 3.12 CGPA by NAAC, Bangalore. The period of accreditation for the current (3rd) cycle is five years, from 2018 to 2023. Now its validity is till December 2029.

The college is ISO 9001:2015 certified and follows excellent management system and committed to work for women social and economic empowerment through academic skills and striking a balance between a career of the woman and a housewife. The focus is on innovative academic methods of teaching, learning and evaluation.

#### Central Research Laboratory

There is a well-furnished advanced Common Research and Instrumentation Centre with characterization facilities. It is also financially assisted by Fund for Improvement of Science & Technology Infrastructure (FIST), Department of Science & Technology (DST), New Delhi. It has generated revenue by providing characterization facilities. There is an e-Learning classroom with advanced facilities.

To inculcate research culture among Under Graduate students a unique scheme Research Promotion Scheme for Budding Researchers is introduced.

#### Research Culture

The college encourages the research activities of the staff and the Post Graduate students. However doctoral research work is conducted in 12 departments with recognized guides and 48 Research students. The college has, to its credit, funded research projects by national agencies such as Consolidation of University Research for Innovation & Excellence in Women Universities(CURIE), Fund for Improvement of Science & Technology Infrastructure (FIST), Indian Council of Social Science Research (ICSSR), etc.

Three research projects under Rajiv Gandhi Science and Technology Commission (RGSTC), Maharashtra Govt. and 17 research projects under Vice-Chancellor Research Motivation Scheme (VCRMS) of Kavayitri Bahinabai Chaudhari North Maharashtra University, Jalgaon (KBCNMU) has been sanctioned to faculty members of the college.

The college offers a plethora of support services to the students. The central library with 59,554 books and a good number of electronic resources.

#### Infrastructural Facilities

Computer center, Center for Mass Media and Foreign languages, Language Laboratory, Music and Dramatics Department. Conference Halls, Canteen, Ladies Common Room, Consumer Co-Op Store, Health Center and Bank are some of the distinctive features provided.

#### Hostel

Two spacious girls' hostels with the intake of 180 students, with Mess facility, have always been a point of attraction to the students.

#### Gymkhana & Department of Sports

The college has playground and provides facilities for many outdoor and indoor games on the campus. The college also takes pride in the state of the art gymnasium and sports facilities with trained coaches. The College has bagged the award of "KBCNMU Best Women's College" in sports for 9 consecutive years.

#### Competent Faculty

The college has 41 qualified teachers out of which about 60 % are M.Phil & Ph.D degree holders. Good number of research papers have been published in National and International Journals. There are 08 research laboratories recognized by the university leading to Ph.D in Geography. Chemistry, Botany, Zoology, Psychology, Sociology, Economics and Hindi. Similarly, laboratories of Electronics have also been recognized. The college provides rich library resources to pursue Ph.D. in Humanities, Mental Moral, Social Sciences streams. So far 12 Doctorates have been produced and currently 5 students are carrying out their research.

The faculty members have completed many University Grant Commission (UGC) Major & Minor research projects. Further 24 research projects sponsored by Non-government agencies have also been completed.

#### School of Skill Development

In this ever changing world and considering the needs of the society and women empowerment, college has started 'School of Skill Development'. School of Skill Development' is running the courses like, B.Voc in Beauty Therapy and Fashion Designing. COC programmes in

Beauty Therapy, modular courses/ short term courses in Fashion Designing & Beauty Therapy.

# Organization of National and International Conferences/ Seminars/ Workshops

As a capacity building endeavor, the college regularly organizes National and International conferences, workshops and seminars.

#### Competitive Examination and Guidance Centre

The expertise, guidance and information regarding various competitive examinations is made available to the students by this centre. Various activities such as seminars, workshops, regarding competitive/ soft skills are also regularly conducted. The Centre has spacious Air Conditioned Library accommodating 150 students at a time. Besides over 1000 books exclusively on competitive examinations, are made available and the centre subscribes magazines and newspapers for the students preparing for civil services examination.

# Distinctive features of the college:

#### **Gymnasium Facilities:**

The college has a spacious very well-equipped Gymnasium for the students of the college. The Gymnasium is available to the students through out the week.

#### Language Laboratory:

A well-equipped digital language laboratory is available to acquaint the students from all streams with the communicative English.

#### Bridge Course:

Teachers from all departments identify certain topics for the first years students. These topics are taught at the beginning of the session before the introduction of the actual syllabus. These selected topics are normally the basics of the "to be taught syllabus." This helps the students to comprehend the curriculum.

#### Computer Literacy Programme:

The college computer Laboratories are very well equipped with latest versions and up-to-date software. The Computer Science Department has on is own started a short term "Computer

Literacy Programme" for the benefit of desirous students from any faculty and the staff members. This efforts has helped many students and staff members gain basic knowledge about computer.

Competitive Examination Guidance Centre: The expertise guidance and information regarding various competitive examination is made available to the students by this centre. Various activities such as seminars, workshops, regarding competitive /soft skills are also conducted.

Infrastructure Facilities: Multi-storey building accommodating modern office - block. Spacious class rooms, Laboratories, Meeting Hall, Conference Hall and Assembly Hall (Saraswati Hall)

- Well-ventilated and hygienic canteen, girls common room, spacious Gymnasium fitted with modern equipments open for students and women of the city.
- UGC network centre
- Health Centre
- Library with separate reading rooms for U. G. and P. G. students.
- Competitive Exam Guidance Centre with Modern Classroom located adjacent to the Library.

Continuous Assessment: We believe that continuous assessment and evaluation of the students is essential for achieving the objective of quality education. Periodical tests, tutorials, home assignments, seminars, group discussion, presentations and mid-semester tests are the methods which are used for assessing the students continuously. The performance of the students in extra curricular activities, co-curricular activities and extension activities is also taken into account and recorded.

#### Participation in Exhibitions & Quiz competitions :

Participation in various educational exhibitions and quiz competitions is another area where college takes special efforts to give more exposure to the students.

Remedial Coaching Scheme: Remedial coaching classes are conducted regularly for the benefit of the academically challenged students.

Cash Awards and Recognitions: We believe that encouragement is key booster to student's overall performance and hence we have constituted special cash award to rank holders from the college funds and through financial assistance.

#### Facillities:

- Suggestion Boxes: The suggestion boxes are kept in the Campus. Valuable suggestions of students received through suggestion boxes are implemented.
- Photocopy Facility: In the college campus
   Photocopy facility is available for the students at the reasonable rates.
- Hostel: The institution has hostel with boarding facility for girls with a total intake capacity of about 200 students. Preference is given to the students coming from rural areas.
- Consumer Store: The college has a students Cooperative Consumer Store in the campus. All stationary articles are available on very reasonable prices to the students.
- Library: The college has a rich library and it is easily accessible to the students from 8.00 am to 5.30 pm. on all working days. The reading rooms in the library remains open up to 11.00 pm. The library has an independent reference section and computerization of its entire functioning. The library has a collection of 59,554 books & subscribes to 83 Magazines and Journals annually and facility e-journals 6,000 & ebooks 31,35,000 on N-List.

The library and the reading hall with reference books is made available for the Alumni for the preparation of NET/SET/MPSC/UPSC/Ph.D.

#### • Departmental Library & Book-Bank Scheme :

Every department has a departmental library having Book Bank Scheme with reference books as well as text books. Apart from central library, students can borrow and refer books from the Departmental Libraries.

 Games & Sports: The college has facility for games like Basketball, Volleyball, Badminton, Table Tennis and Softball in the campus. For major outdoor games like Football, Hockey and Cricket the play ground of the stadium adjacent to the college is available to the students. The students do well in sports at all College/ University/State/National and International level competitions. The College has bagged the award of "KBC NMU Best Women's College" in sports for 9 consecutive years.

- Medical Facility: The campus has a Medical Center which caters to the medical needs of the students pertaining to minor ailments.
- Laboratories: Laboratories for Physics, Electronics, Chemistry, Botany, Zoology, Computer Science, Geography, Psychology, Language Lab are well equipped with latest instruments and equipments. In addition the college has modem educational equipments like Slide Projector, Overhead Projector and L.C.D. Projector. Well furnished Computer Laboratory with Internet facility is available.

#### Common Research Centre :

The college has Common Research Centre, which is useful for research work and promote research attitude among teachers and students. The special instruments like Fourier Transform Infrared Spectrophotometer (FTIR), UV-Visible Spectrometer. Tissue Processor, High Pressure Autoclave, Polarimeter, Flame Photimeter, Penta - Head Research Microscope, Fluorescence Microscope, Digital Research Microscope, High Power Red LASER, Spin Coating System, Digital Balance etc. are available at Common Research Centre. The Research Committee looks after the functioning of the laboratory. Research Lab offers services like testing and analysis of chemicals and samples of research scholars and faculties.

- Communication Facility: Solar mobile charger and Wifi Facility.
- Internet Facility: The college has a full-fledged Network centre with the facility of internet connection. Also every science department has internet facility. Students are given access to use internet every day in network centre as well as in the departments.

- Assembly Hall: An independent and wellequipped Assembly Hall (Saraswati Hall) is available for the students for various activities.
- Conference Hall: Available for students to pursue various co-curriculers activities.

#### Financial assistance and support services:

#### Student Welfare Fund:

The teaching and non teaching faculty members contribute certain amount on their birthdays to this fund. From this amount financial help is given to needy students.

For every scholarship students should have updated Aadhar Card with her own mobile number, her own bank account. If students fill the online forms is due course of time the scholarships are credited to their own account without hostie. This scheme is jointly funded by KBCNMU, Jalgaon.

# Hindustan Petroleum Corporation Ltd. Scholarship:

This is for the girls who are handicapped or belonging to either, scheduled caste, scheduled tribe or from other backward class.

Each Scholarship has specific norms for initial sanction and continuation. These are displayed on the notice board at appropriate time.

#### Students Service and Activities :

- Personality Development: Extra Curricular
  Activities through various committees such as Arts
  Circle, Debating Committee, Science Association.
  Yuvati Sabha, etc. are continuously organized in
  college. These committees provide platform and
  opportunities for their overall development.
- Study Tours and Excursions: Faculty and department wise Educational tours/Industrial visit are arranged for the students.
- Student Counseling: At the time of the admission, the college frames an Admission Committee from among the teachers, to assist and guide the students in filling up of admission form, in the selection of faculty, subject combination etc. Parents who accompany their wards at the time of the admission are also actively involved. Besides, a counseling committee is easily accessible to students for the advice and guidance on academic, psychological problems and personal matters throughout the academic session and mentor mentee scheme is also easily accessible to students.
- Cultural and Extra Curricular Activities : Under the guidance and monitoring of the Arts Circle, a continuous process of Cultural Activities goes on in the campus. The Students are encouraged to participate in different cultural activities, the best of which are selected for the college Annual Social Gathering and Yuvarang', the Youth Festival of the KBC North Maharashtra University Jalgaon. Similarly, extracurricular activities like elocution, debating, easy writing, science-quiz, commerce-quiz, etc. are managed by the students through the Debating Club, the Science Association etc. Our Students have also made a mark in 'Avishkar' a research oriented competition organized by the KBC North Maharashtra University, Jalgaon.
- Students' Council: In every academic year Students Council is constituted as per the provisions of the University Act. Students Council is actively involved in the proper functioning of the college. The Council acts as a medium between the

Principal and the Students in general. All problems concerning the students are discussed during frequent meetings over the academic year.

- N.C.C.: The college has an NCC unit with 55 registered cadets. New cadets are enrolled every year in July. The primary aim of NCC is to instill qualities such as character, courage, comradeship, discipline, leadership, a secular outlooks, a spirit of adventure and a commitment to selfless service among the youth of the country.
- N.S.S.: The college runs the National Scheme (NSS), enrolling approximately 250 students each year. The NSS unit is efficiently managed by one program officer and two Assistant Professor Officer. The primary objective of NSS is to integrate community service with higher education, fostering a sense of social responsibility and leadership among students. Through various outreach activities, NSS volunteers engage in community development, awareness campaigns, and social welfare initiatives, contributing to their holistic growth while making a meaningful impact on society.
- Grievance Redressal Cell: Students can approach
  the Principal directly or through suggestion boxes
  placed at convenient locations, on the campus for
  the redressal of their grievances. Besides, a
  Grievance Redressal Cell is constituted every year
  and remains functional throughout the session.
- Alumni Association: Alumni Association Registered under the Society Registration Act 1860 (XXI of 1860) functions as a nodal agency for maintaining liaison with the Alumni Efforts are on to involve ex-students in the development of the college by undertaking and facilitating conferences, seminars, lectures involvement in cultural programmes and meeting amongst alumnae, students and faculty.
- Prevention of Sexual Harassment Committee:
   As per the norms of the university committee is functional on the campus and any student having complaint in this regard can approach the committee.

- Career Guidance and Placement Cell: The cell is active on the campus to make the students aware of the job opportunities through Campus Interviews.
- Vehicle Parking: There is a spacious parking lot for the students and the staff on the campus.
- Research Promotion Scheme for budding research.

From the academic year 2021-22 the Research Promotion Scheme for budding researchers implemented in the college. This golden opportunity provided to the students to meet the challenges of rapidly changing world through participation in the scheme. To nurture the students to rise at national and international horizons, 'Budding Researchers' Scheme' is an innovation for developing research aptitude amongst students.

# Three/Four Year Under Graduate Degree Programmes With Honours Or Honours with research offered by the college for Academic Year 2024-2025 under NEP 2020

Dr. Annasaheb G. D. Bendale Mahila Mahavidyalaya, Jalgaon received 'Autonomous Status' is one of the renowned college in Khandesh region. It is affiliated to KBC North Maharashtra University. The Nation's Education Policy 2020 is being implemented for the first time by the college from year 2024-2025 in the jurisdiction of KBC North Maharashtra University region. The UGC has revised the CBCS and developed a new Curriculum and Credit Framework (CCF) for undergraduate and post graduate programmes. New Education Policy (NEP) is being implemented by the Indian government's ministry of human resource development (MHRD) beginning with the 2023–24 academic year.

### Objectives of NEP 2020

- To promote holistic development of students having the world view of a truly global citizen.
- To provide flexibility to students so that learners have the ability to choose their learning

trajectories and programmes, and thereby choose their paths in life according to their talents and interests.

- To eliminate harmful hierarchies among disciplines/fields of study and silos between different areas of learning.
- Multidisciplinary and holistic education to ensure the unity and integrity of all knowledge.
- To promote creativity and critical thinking and to encourage logical decision-making and innovation.
- To promote human ethics & Constitutional values.
- To promote multilingualism and the power of language in learning and teaching.
- To impart life skills such as communication, cooperation, teamwork, and resilience.
- To promote outstanding research as a corequisite for outstanding education and development.

 To incorporate Indian Knowledge System relevant for a particular discipline or field of studies.

Under NEP, various courses to be learn by student are categorised under the following heads:-

- Course: A basic unit of education and/or training. It means a paper which is taught for at least one semester as a part of a subject and is a component.
- Major DSC (Mandatory): The subject represents the main focus of the degree, and the degree will be awarded in that subject. Students should secure a minimum of 50% of total credits through Major (core) Courses (mandatory courses, electives, vocational courses, Internship/ Field Projects / Apprenticeship / Community Engagement Projects, Seminars, and Group Discussions. In addition, Entrepreneurship, IPR and Research Projects shall be offered in case of Honors with Research Degree) in Three/Four Years for the award of a Major Degree. Major Specific IKS is included under Major.
- Elective Course DSE: Generally, a course which can be chosen from a pool of courses and which may be very specific or specialized or advanced or supportive to the discipline/subject of study or which provides an extended scope or which enables exposure to some other discipline/subject/domain or nurtures the candidate's proficiency/skill is called an Elective Course.
- Minor: is the subject that may complement the Major subject or can have interdisciplinary bandwidth. Minor subjects may be related or unrelated to the Major subject. The Minor subjects may be from the different disciplines of the same DSC Major (Core) faculty or from different faculty altogether.
- GE/OE: An elective course chosen generally from an unrelated discipline/subject, with an intention to seek multidisciplinary exposure is called a Generic Elective. It is to be chosen

compulsorily from faculty other than that of the Major and from the faculty-wise baskets of OE prepared by Colleges.

- VESC: vocational and skill enhancement courses include
  - · SEC (Skill Enhancement Courses) and
- VSC (Vocational Skill Courses), to be selected from the basket of Skill Courses approved by Colleges. These courses aim to provide students with hands-on training, competencies, proficiency and skills. The courses are expected to enhance skill and employability.
- AEC (Ability Enhancement Courses): includes English: 02 Credits, Modern Indian Language: 02 credits

#### VEC (Value Education Courses):

To be chosen from the courses, such as: Understanding India, Environmental Science/ Education, Digital and Technological Solutions, the Constitution of India, Ethics and Value Education

- IKS (Indian Knowledge system): Courses on IKS to be selected from the basket of IKS courses approved by the college. The course is based on the Indian Knowledge system, such as historical accounts of science in India, ancient Ayurveda.
- CC (Co-curricular Courses): to be chosen from the courses, such as; Health and Wellness, Yoga education, Sports and fitness, Cultural Activities, NSS/NCC and Fine/Applied/ Visual/ Performing Arts.
- Research Project/ Dissertation: Project work
  is considered a special course involving the
  application of knowledge in solving / analyzing /
  exploring a real-life situation / difficult problem.
  The student undertakes Research in specific areas
  of his Major/ Core Subject with advisory support
  from a teacher / faculty member Academic Bank
  of Credits (ABC): Academic Bank of Credits
  (ABC) is the initiative of Ministry of Electronics
  and Information Technology (MeiT) and Ministry

of Education (MoE) respectively. As per National Education Policy 2020, the Academic Bank of Credit (ABC) has been envisage, to facilitate the academic mobility of students with the freedom to study across the higher education institutions in the country with an appropriate "credit transfer" mechanism from one programme to another,

leading to attain a Degree/ Diploma/ PG diploma, etc.

The program will includes Four-Year Multidisciplinary Degree Programme with Multiple Entry and Exit Options as given below:

## Admission Path at Different Levels for Four-year Multidisciplinary Degree Programme

## a. First Year Entry 1, Level 4.5

- Students who have successfully completed the Grade 12 School Leaving Certificate or equivalent shall be eligible for admission to a first-year degree programme.
- The entry requirement for Level 4.5 is the Secondary School Leaving Certificate obtained after completing Grade 12 or Level 4 successfully.
- A programme of study leading to entry into the first year of the Bachelor's degree is open to those who have met the entrance requirements, including specified levels of attainment at the secondary level of education specified in the programme admission regulations of the respective university.
- Admission to the Bachelor's degree programme is based on the evaluation of documentary evidence (including the academic record) of the applicant's ability to undertake and

complete a Bachelor's degree programme.

 The admission shall be made on merit based on criteria notified by the university, keeping in view the guidelines/norms issued by the UGC, the government of Maharashtra and other statutory bodies concerned and taking into account the reservation policy as and when issued by the Government of Maharashtra from time to time.

#### b. Second Year Entry 2 Level 5.0

- The entry requirement for Level 5.0 is a certificate obtained after completing the undergraduate programme's first year (two semesters).
- A programme of study leading to the second year of the Bachelor's degree is open to those who have met the entrance requirements, including specified levels of attainment, in the programme admission regulations.
- Admission to a programme of study is based

on the evaluation of documentary evidence (including the academic record) of the applicant's ability to undertake and complete a bachelor's degree programme.

#### c. Third Year Entry 3 Level 5.5

- The entry requirement for Level 5.5 is a diploma obtained after completing two years (four semesters) of the undergraduate programme.
- A programme of study leading to the Bachelor's degree is open to those who have met the entrance requirements, including specified levels of attainment, in the programme admission regulations.
- Admission to a programme of study is based on the evaluation of documentary evidence (including the academic record) of the applicant's ability to undertake and complete a bachelor's degree programme.

# d. Fourth Year Entry 4 Level 6 (P.G. First year)

- An individual seeking admission to a Bachelor's degree (Honours) and Bachelor's degree (Research) (Level 6) in a specified field of learning would generally have completed all requirements of the relevant three-year Bachelor's degree (Level 5.5).
- Therefore, after completing the three-year Bachelor's degree requirements, candidates who meet the minimum CGPA of 7.5 or the minimum eligibility criteria decided by the University Academic Council shall be allowed to continue studies in the fourth year of the undergraduate programme to pursue and complete the Bachelor's degree with Research.

#### Master's Programme Admission Path

 Students shall be admitted to a two-year programme, with the second year devoted entirely to research for those who have completed the three- year Bachelor's programme.

 Students completing a four-year bachelor's programme with Honours/Research may be admitted to a one-year Master's programme.

# e. Fifth Year Entry 5 Level 6.5 (P.G. Second Year)

The admission requirements for Entry 5, level 6.5 is as given below:

- A four year Bachelor's Degree (Honours/ Research) for the one-year/two- semester Master's degree programme.
- A three year Bachelor's Degree for the twoyear/ four- semester Master's degree programme with an exit option after successful completion of the first year of PG Programme.
- A three year Bachelor's Degree for the oneyear/two-semester Post-Graduate Diploma programme.

A programme of study leading to the Master's degree and Post-Graduate Diploma (PGD) is open to those who have met the entrance requirements, including specified levels of attainment, in the programme admission regulations. Admission to a programme of study is based on the evaluation of documentary evidence (including the academic record) of the applicant's ability to undertake post-graduate study in a specialized field of enquiry.

# Lateral Entry/ Re-entry at Higher Levels after Exit from Lower Levels of Four Year Multidisciplinary UG Degree Programme

- Students who leave with a Certification,
   Diploma, or a Basic Bachelor's Degree will be eligible to re-enter the programme at the exit level to complete or progress to the next level through lateral entry mode.
- Any consequential vacancies caused by exits to an ongoing programme (four-year Degree

Programme and Integrated Master's or second year Master's) plus vacancies created due to % failure in the previous year.

- Lateral entry is open to those students if she has either
- a. Successfully completed the first year/second year/third year of the particular four year multidisciplinary degree programme in any ABC registered HEI with valid credits in ABC and reentering into the second year/third year/fourth year, respectively of the same four year degree programme of any ABC registered HEI, within stipulated/ permissible period of years as decided by Statutory Councils of that HEI
- b. Already successfully completed a multidisciplinary four-year first-degree programme and is desirous of and academically capable of pursuing another multidisciplinary four year firstdegree programme in an allied subject. A student will be allowed to enter/re-enter only during the odd semester. Re-entry at various levels for lateral entrants in academic programmes should be based on the earned and valid credits as deposited and accumulated in Academic Bank of Credits (ABC) through Registered Higher Education

Institutions (RHEI) and proficiency test records. Hence, the University/ College will have to work out prerequisites and entry norms for lateral admissions, such as previous year CGPA, a written test and/or interview, requirement of bridge courses etc. In case the lateral entrant is desirous of joining four year degree programme different from his/her earlier programme (i.e. with different combinations of Major and Minor), then the BoS of that HEI should decide the requirements of bridge courses, prerequisite courses and additional credit requirements for new combinations of Major and Minor which the lateral entrant must fulfil for the purpose of joining the new programme. However, in terms of the admission eligibility requirements, the student must belong to the same faculty/ discipline in terms of Major Subject i.e., the Major subject of his/her earlier programme and the Major subject of a new programme for which he/she is seeking admission must be from the same faculty/discipline. Reservation for lateral entry will have to be executed as per the Government of Maharashtra Norms.

# EXAMINATION & EVALUATION (NEP 2020 PATTERN)

The Evaluation of the student shall be divided into two parts viz. End Semester Examination (ESE) and Continuous Internal Assessment (CIA) with a weightage in the ratio of 60:40 for UG and PG Courses under NEP 2020 Pattern.

It means, the distribution of marks for every theory / practical paper at End Semester Examinations and for Continuous Internal Assessment shall be as follows:

In order to pass the examinations a candidate has to obtain at least 40% marks for each paper in ESE and CIA exams separately.

Rules of Continuous Internal Evaluation

The Continuous Internal Evaluation for theory papers shall consist of two methods:

#### Continuous & Comprehensive Evaluation (CCE):

CCE will carry a maximum of 30% weightage (30 OR/15 marks) of the total marks for a course. Before the start of the academic session in each semester, the subject teacher should choose any three assessment methods from the following list, with each method carrying 10 OR/5 marks:

- Short Answered Paper Based
- Long Answered Paper Based
- Online or Offline MCQ Based
- 4. Seminars (Online or Offline)
- Tutorials
- Oral Test (Online or Offline)
- 7. Homework Assignments

#### 2. Internal Assessment Tests (IAT):

IAT will carry a maximum of 10% weightage (10/5 marks) of the total marks for a course. IAT shall be conducted at the end of the semester and will assess the remaining unit of the syllabus that was not covered by the CCEs. The subject teacher is at liberty to decide which units are to be assessed using CCEs and which unit is to be assessed on the basis of IAT

- The overall weightage of Continuous Internal Evaluation (CIE + IAT) shall be 40% of the total marks for the course.
- The remaining 60% of the marks shall be allocated to the Semester End Examination (ESE).
- Continuous Internal Assessment (CIA) examination methods will be as per the rules defined by the concern department.
- Subject teacher has freedom to choose CCE method and corresponding syllabus unit required to communicate to the students at the beginning of the semester to ensure clarity and proper preparation.

## University Ordinance Regarding Maintenance Of Discipline & Good Conduct

- Every student, during the term of course, shall be within the disciplinary jurisdiction of Competent Authority and the authority shall take appropriate action, in case of indiscipline or misconduct on the part of the student.
- Definitions in this Ordinance unless the context otherwise requires.
- 2.1 "Student" means and includes a person who is enrolled as such by the University, Affiliated College or Recognized institutions for receiving instructions and / or qualifying for any degree or diploma or certificate awarded by the University. This includes External students also.
- 2.2 "Institutions" means and includes University/ Affiliated College / Recognized Institutions as the case many inclusive of Campus, Hostels, Play Grounds, Laboratory, Libraries, Gymnasiums thereof.
- 2.3 "Competent Authority" for the purposes of this Ordinance means and includes Head of the Teaching Departments of the University, Principal of the Affiliated College, Head of the Recognized Institution for the concerned students and such other person vested with the authority by Vice Chancellor for external students. Provided in respect of misconduct regarding University examination, Executive Council shall only be the Competent Authority.
- Obligations of the Students : Every students shall all times.
- 3.1 Conduct themselves properly.
- 3.2 Maintain proper behavior.
- 3.3 Observe strict discipline both within the campus of the Institution, Hostel and also outside in Buses, Railway trains or at public places or Picnic or Educational Trips arranged by the Institution or at Playgrounds.
- 3.4 Ensure that no act of theirs consciously or unconsciously brings the Institution or any establishment or authority connected with it into disrepute.

- 3.5 Shall not lodge any complaint or make any representation regarding any matter connected with Institution to press or other outside Institution agency etc. without forwarding the same through the Head of the connected Institution.
- 4) Any act of a student which is contrary to the provisions of clause (3) shall constitute misconduct and or indiscipline which terms shall mean and include among others any one or more of the acts jointly or severally mentioned thereafter namely.
- 4.1 Any act that directly or indirectly causes or attempts to cause disturbance in the lawful functioning of the Institution.
- 4.2 Habitual un-punctuality in attending in lectures, practicals tutorials & other courses as may be prescribed.
- 4.3 Repeated absence from lecture, tutorials, practicals, and other courses, as prescribed.
- 4.4 Canvassing for or accepting contributions or otherwise associating themselves with rasing of any fund or any collection in cash or in kind pursuance of any object whatsoever without the previous sanction of the Competent Authority.
- 4.5 Occupation of any building such as Hostel room, residential quarter or such other accommodation the premises owned or hired by the Institution without prior permission of the Competent Authority.
- 4.6 Permitting or coming with any person not authorized to occupy any Hostel room, residential quarter or any accommodation or any part there of or of the Institution.
- 4.7 Securing admission to the Institution to any under graduate or post graduate programme or any other course by fabrication or by suppression of facts or information.

- 4.8 Obstruction to any student or group of students in his / her or their legitimate activities as such whether in the class room, laboratories, fields, Play-Ground, Gymnasium or places of social & cultural activity within the campus of the Institution.
- 4.9 Suppressing material, information of supply of false information to the institution for seeking any privilege.
- 4.10 Possessing or using any firearms, lethal weapons, explosives or dangerous or corrosive substance on the premises of the Institution.
- 4.11 Possessing or consuming any poisonous or stupefying drug or intoxicant in any form in the Institution.
- 4.12 Ragging, bullying or harassing any student in institution or outside thereof.
- 4.13 Indulging in any act as would cause annoyance or embarrassment to any other student or member of the authorities of the Institution or staffmember or any member of the family of the staff.
- 4.14 Indulging in any act of violence, assault, intimidation or threatening in the institution or Hostel or outside thereof.
- 4.15 Destroying or attempting to destroy or tamper with any official record or document of the institution.
- 4.16 Conduct, unbecoming of the student any meeting or special function or sports & cultural activities arranged by the institution or any other public place.
- 4.17 Stealing or damaging any farm produce or any property belonging to the institution, staff member of the institution or any other student.
- 4.18 Instigating violence, participating in any violent demonstrations or violent agitation or violent strike in the institution.
- 4.19 Instigating or participating in any 'Gherao' of any official or staff member of the institution.
- 4.20 Violation of any of the Rules & Regulations of the institution or orders of the Competent Authority

- 4.21 Gambling in any form in the Institution.
- 4.22 Disorderly behavior in any form or any act specifically forbidden by the Competent Authority.
- 4.23 Refusal to appear to give evidence before Enquiry Officer appointed by the Competent Authority with respect to a charge against them.
- 4.24 Any act violating any provision of the NMU University act, Statutes Ordinances, Rules made thereunder.
- 4.25 Conviction in the Court of Law for criminal offence involving moral turpitude.
- 4.26 Any other act not specifically maintained here before which whether by commission or omission as would in the circumstances as an act of misconduct or indiscipline.
- The competent authority may impose any one or more of the following punishments on the students found guilty of misconduct or indiscipline proportion thereof.
- 5.1 Warning/Censure/Reprimand
- 5.2 Fine not exceeding Rs. 1,000/-.
- 5.3 Cancellation of the Scholarship /Award /Prize Medal, awarded to the student by the concerned institution, with retrospective effect.
- 5.4 Expulsion from the concerned Institution.
- 5.5 Debarring from the admission to a course or courses of study in the concerned institution. Debarring from appearing for examination or examinations conducted by the institution concerned for a specific period not exceeding 5 years.
- 5.6 Cancellation of the result of the student concerned in the examination of the concerned instruction in which he/she has appeared.
- 5.7 Rustication from institution for the period not exceeding 5 years.
- 6) If the Competent Authority is satisfied that there is prima case for inflicting penalties mentioned in clause No.5 it may itself or through other

- person/persons authorized by it for this purpose shall make an enquiry in following manner.
- 6.1 Due notice in writing shall be given to the student concerned about her alleged act of misconduct / indiscipline.
- 6.2 The student charged shall be required, within 15 days of the notice, to submit her written representation about such charges.
- 6.3 If the student fails to submit his written representation within the specified time limit, the inquiry may be held expert.
- 6.4 If oral evidence of the witnesses against student is recorded by the enquiry Authority the student charged shall be given an opportunity to cross examine the witness concerned.
- 6.5 If the student charged desires to see the relevant documents such documents as are being taken into consideration or relevant to the charges may, at the discretion of proving the charge or charge may at the discretion of proving the Enquiry Authority, be shown to her after the notice as provided in sub clause(I) above is furnished to her.
- 6.6 The students charged shall be required to produce document, if any, in support of her defense. The Enquiry Authority may admit relevant evidence, documentary or otherwise, at any stage before the final orders are passed.
- 6.7 Legal practitioner shall not be allowed to appear on behalf of the student charge in the proceedings before the Enquiry Authority.
- 6.8 The Enquiry Authority shall record finding on each, allegation of misconduct or indiscipline & the reasons for such finding and submit the report along with proceedings to the Competent Authority.
- 6.9 The Competent Authority on the basis of findings shall pass such orders as it deems fit.
- Provided procedure prescribed above need not be followed & all or any of its provisions may be waived in the following circumstances.

- 7.1 When the student charged admits the charge in writing.
- 7.2 When the order of punishment is to be based on facts, which have led to the conviction of the student charged for the offense involving moral turpitude.
- 7.3 When the student charged has absconded or for any other reason it is impracticable to communicate with her.
- 7.4 If in the opinion of the Competent Authority, a punishment or fine not exceeding Rs. 50/- or reprimand censure, warning is sufficient.
- 8) If the punishment of rustication is imposed on a student, by Principal of the College Head of the Institution / Head of the Teaching Department of the University or such other person to whom the authority is vested by the Vice-Chancellor. If the punishment is imposed by the Vice-Chancellor the student shall be entitled to prefer an appeal to the Executive Council of the University within thirty days of the receipt of the notice of the punishment.
- In respect of such student, Head of the Institution shall maintain a record of the punishment.
- 10) The Institution shall, on each occasion of any punishment being imposed on any student, intimate by a letter to be sent Under Certificate of Posting the fact of such imposition to the parent or guardian of such student on the address available in the college records.
- 11) A copy of these rules shall be supplied to each student at the time of her admission to the Institution and receipt for these same shall be obtained from the student. This receipt shall form a part of the record of admission of the student.
- 12) If any foreign student is admitted for any course, the concerned Institution shall send copy of the rules to the concerned foreign embassy and department of External affairs.

## **ANTI - RAGGING**

## According to UGC Regulations on Curbing the Menace of Ragging In Higher Educational Institutions - 2009

# Administrative action in the event of ragging:-

- The institution shall punish a student found guilty ragging after following the procedure and in the manner prescribed in under here:
- a) The Anti-Ragging Committee of the institution shall take an appropriate decision, regarding punishment or otherwise, depending on the facts of each incident of ragging and nature and gravity of the incident of ragging established in the recommendations of the Anti-Ragging Squad.
- The Anti-Ragging Committee may, depending on the nature and gravity of the guilt established by the Anti-Ragging Squad, award, to those found guilty, one or more of the following punishments, namely;
- Suspension from attending classes and academic privileges.
- Withholding/withdrawing scholarship/ fellowship and other benefits.
- Debarring from appearing in any test/ examination or other evaluation process.
- iv. Withholding results.

- Debarring from representing the institution in any regional, national or international meet, tournament, youth festival etc.
- vi. Suspension / expulsion from the hostel.
- vii. Cancellation of admission.
- viii. Rustication from the institution for a period ranging from one to four semesters.
- ix. Expulsion from the institution and consequent debarring from admission to any other institution for a specified period. Provided that where the persons committing or abetting the act of ragging are not identified, the institution shall resort to collective punishment.
- An appeal against the order of punishment by the Anti-Ragging Committee shall lie,
- in case the of an order of an institution, affiliated to or constituent part, of a University, to the Vice-Chancellor of the University
- ii. In case of an order of a University, to its Chancellor.
- iii. in case of an institution of national importance created by an Act of Parliament, to the Chairman or Chancellor of the institution, as the case may be.
